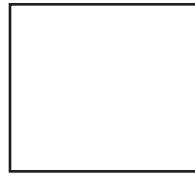


How can you help?

- **Spread the News** – Tell your friends and neighbors that we are here and ready to serve them!



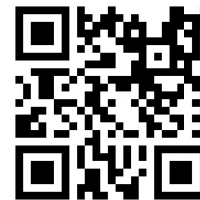

Our services are geared to provide this opportunity to each individual regardless of their ability level.

What does Lighthouse do?

Lighthouse provides an array of services to individuals with developmental disabilities, including Vocational Skills Training, Employment Services, Community Participation Supports, “Strengthening Pathways” Adult Training, Student Transition Services, The SHINE Collective (Spreading Hope In Neighborly Encounters), and “Without Walls” Virtual Learning.

These services are customized to meet the unique needs of each individual and are tailored to their interests and goals.
